Dear Friends,

As a veteran, you served our Country when called upon. I cannot thank you enough for what you have done to protect our freedoms and our way of life. All Americans will be forever indebted to you for your service.

Here in Nassau County, we appreciate the sacrifices you have made for your patriotic duty. As a result, I am happy to announce that the partial real property tax exemption has been increased to fifteen percent for Cold War Veterans in Nassau.

Qualified real property owned by a Cold War Veteran or an otherwise qualified owner shall be exempt from County taxation to the maximum fifteen percent of the assessed value of the property (provided that the exemption does not exceed \$54,000, or the product of \$54,000 multiplied by the latest class ratio). Please note that you are eligible for the Cold War Veteran exemption only if you are not already receiving a veteran's tax exemption

Hopefully this increase in the exemption can help provide some relief to your household. Along with the new Legislative Majority and new County Executive, I am working hard to decrease the tax burden on all taxpayers. You fought admirably for your Country when asked. Now it's my turn to fight for you. As your Legislator and as an American, I thank you.
